The Committee will meet again on December 4, and plans for the June Annual Meeting continue. This Committee is responsible for nominating officers and new Board members.

New Business: A discussion of increasing classes at Duncaster was deferred to the next Board meeting. June Johnson and Bertina will get information regarding the Independent Learning in Retirement conference in New Bedford this fall and email this information to the Board to determine interest in attending.
