## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board meeting of the Adult Learning Program was called to order by Phil Will at one o'clock. There were present: Ann Winship, Bob Ellis, Bob Hewey, Donna Cote, Dan Heuer, Marilyn Stockton, Agnes Pier, Libbie Merrow, Bob LaPorte and Bertina Williams. There was no report from Seabury staff.

The Minutes of the meeting of 25 October 2018 were accepted with corrections and additions.

For the Membership Committee, Dan Heuer reported that Gregory Woodward, President of the University of Hartford, will be the speaker for the spring Preview meeting. Dan asked that the free coupon that appears in the ALP-Horn be continued for one more issue but the Raffle would not take place at the Preview Meeting but rather would be done at the Annual Meeting.

Regarding Old Business, the issue of having class notes from the class 'Study Ourselves' be available to class members was brought up and it was decided that the Presenter, Noreen Channels would take care of making the class notes public via PowerPoint and shared Google Drive so anyone can have access to them.

The meeting was adjourned at two-thirty o'clock.
